- Výzvy na předkládání projektů, jedno- a dvoukolové
- Pracovní program stanoví kritéria a podrobnosti akce
 - Obecné cíle, problém, který se má řešit,
 - Rozsah činností, očekávané dopady
- Hodnocení návrhů – excelence, dopad, kvalita a efektivita provádění
- Projekty vybrané pro financování - uzavírá se s EC Grantová dohoda a mezi řešiteli Konsorciální dohoda
- Veškerá komunikace probíhá elektronicky „Participant portal“

Přímé náklady

- Osobní náklady účastníků
 - Mzda dle výše úvazku v projektu + odměny max. 8000 € na plný úvazek za rok, hrazeny jen produktivní hodiny na akci
- Cestovní náklady
- Ostatní přímé náklady
- Investice
- Subdovávky

Nepřímé náklady (režie)

- sazba 25% z přímých nákladů bez subdodávek

Sazby náhrad EC zpravidla 100% , pro inovační akce 70%



New calls for expression of interest for individual experts and for organisations to suggest experts were just published in OJ C342 of 22 November 2013. European Commission will soon need experts to evaluate first Horizon 2020 proposals. Don't forget to tick the H2020 box in the registration platform and update your expertise.

Join the database of independent experts for European research and innovation. The European Commission appoints independent experts to assist with research and innovation assignments including the evaluation of proposals, monitoring of projects, and evaluation of programmes, and design of policy.

New experts

Who can be an expert?

You have a chance of being selected as an expert if you:

- have high-level of expertise in the relevant fields of research and innovation (see call for details on types of expertise).
- can be available for occasional, short-term assignments

What do expert assignments involve?

Experts, as peer reviewers, assist in the:

- evaluation of proposals
- monitoring of actions

In addition, experts assist in the :

- preparation, implementation or evaluation of programmes and design of policies.
